## Profile

Rebecca has been a member of Old Square Chambers since the successful completion of her pupillage in 1998-1999. Her main area of practice is employment and discrimination law, but having also practiced in the field of personal injury for 10 years, she enjoys considerable expertise in 'crossover' areas such as stress at work claims and discrimination cases in which personal injury damages are sought in employment tribunals.
